### Welcome Back Woodland families and staff!!

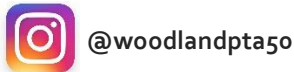

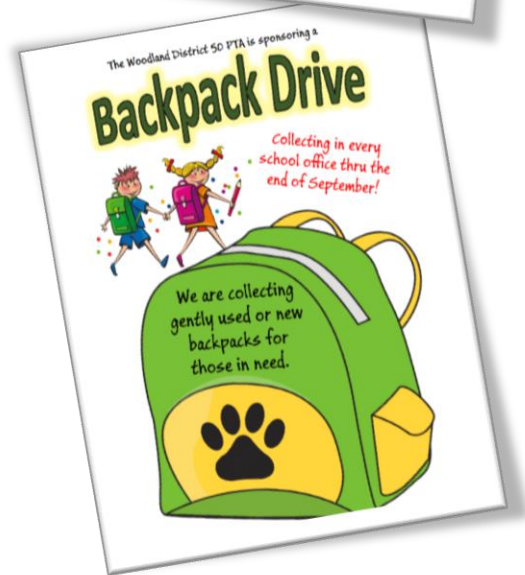
